1. Due to the popularity of this exhibit, each artist is limited to the submission of **ONE** artwork.
 2. Artists must reside in the Southeastern region of Manitoba. The Southeastern region is defined on the North by Highway 44, on the West by Highway 75, on the East by the Ontario border, and on the South by the United States border.
 3. All entries must be original works, designed by the artist, preferably executed within the last 2 years, and not previously judged.
 4. All artwork must remain with the exhibit for the duration of the show.
 5. Upon submission, all artwork must be properly framed or mounted and ready for display. Not sure what this means? See the box below!
 6. SAC will promote sales of artworks. You will be pleased to know that a 20% commission from all sales will help to support Visual Arts Programs and Exhibits at the Steinbach Cultural Arts Centre.
 7. **IMPORTANT:** The Steinbach Cultural Arts Centre and the Steinbach Arts Council assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any entries or exhibits. Private insurance of personal artworks is always recommended - the Centre has limited insurance.
 8. Please feel free to contact the SAC staff if you need assistance with preparing your artwork for hanging.
- Please Note:** SAC Staff reserve the right to refuse any artwork that does not meet these conditions for hanging, or that is deemed inappropriate.

HOW TO PREPARE ARTWORKS FOR HANGING

Artists are required to supply 2 screw-in eye hooks for their artwork. Eye hooks must be 1cm in diameter to accommodate the hanging apparatus in our gallery.

EYE HOOK POSITIONING

Size of Artwork	Where to Mount Eye Hooks
8"x10" or smaller	2" from the top of the artwork, 1 hook on either side.
9"x11" or larger	3" from the top of the artwork, 1 hook on either side.
